

3. Review of Academic Progress

Dr. BalaKoteswari said that in terms of academic progress SSB has done its best in completing the academic requirements of the MBA program in sync with JNTUA requirements.

- Online classes commenced for IIIrd semester MBA students with daily 4 hr time table from 9 AM to 3 PM
- Students have completed many value added courses from NPTEL and COURSERA during the pandemic.
- · Many industry connect activities were organized ranging from Guest lecturers to Workshops to Seminars and Symposiums.
- Webinars were organized in pandemic situation.
- Faculty also enrolled in various online courses and completed.
- Faculty participated in various FDP's, Workshops, Seminars and Webinars.

Dr. Vaishali appreciated the efforts of the team in organizing many events which will help in enriching the knowledge of the students and give a good exposure to the industry.

4. University Examination Conduction

As per JNTUA guidelines IV semester MBA exams were conducted from 12th of September to 19th September in the department. Students were given a choice of opting for the exam centers in their native places as well. 2ndMid term examinations were conducted simultaneously. Forenoon End term exam was conducted and Afternoon Midterm exam was conducted following proper COVID guidelines. Students were directed to wear mask and follow social distancing. Each exam room was allocated with 12 students only and exam was conducted under surveillance. Other Special care was taken regarding other Institution students who were writing examination in our campus. Supplementary examination registrations are in progress and examinations are scheduled after 8th of October 2020.

Dr. Rajendra Prasad said that special care was taken by the exam team to ensure smooth conduction of the examination and coordinating with the University for Necessary Requirement. Dr. Channa Reddy congratulated the team for the successful conduction of the university examination

Result Analysis was presented before the members. Special care should be taken for the 1st semester subjects Statistics for managers where 41 students failed out of 132 and Information technology for managers where there are 47 failures out of 132.

7. Placement Details

Dr. BalaKoteswari presented the Placement initiatives taken up for employment of the students. Dedicated placement team working on enhancing the skills of the students and grooming the student's right from their inception into the MBA program. Knowing the industry requirement and integrating it with the placement activities is the hallmarks of the placement team. 89 students were placed in reputed companies.
