

3.2 Award of Diploma

RESPONSIBILITIES OF SECOND PARTY 4.

SECOND PARTY shall be responsible for:

Marketing and promotion including local media advertising of the programme at 4.1 its own cost. The advertisement material to be issued by SECOND PARTY shall be vetted by AIMA before release. Fart of Cost of National level media advertising programme by AIMA shall be borne by the Second Party as decided by AIMA.

Use of AIMA brand and logo name shall be strictly as per AIMA norm/specifications.

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1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1 Second Party will provide Co-ordination services in respect of the Courses between AIMA and the students enrolled in AIMA programs, and conduct of contact classes as per the terms and conditions agreed to herein. The relationship between the parties is restricted to the above, and shall not amount to a Franchisor- Franchisee relationship or a partnership.

1.4 Course Administration

All processes involved in the Courses such as selection of candidates, admissions, evaluation, teaching, examination, certification etc. of the candidates shall be carried out by AIMA from its Headquarters.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF SECOND PARTY

SECOND PARTY shall be responsible for:

2.1 (a) Use of AIMA brand and logo name shall be strictly as per AIMA norm/specifications. The cost of all marketing, promotional and coordination activities, including advertisements, shall be borne by the Second Party. The content of all marketing and promotional material, whether in print or on through any electronic means, shall be as per Schedule 'B' hereto, which may be changed as per the sole discretion of AIMA.
