

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

Dr. BalaKoteswari, Member Secretary, Principal-SSB welcomed the members to the meeting and presented the details as per the agenda


Agenda for Discussion

4. University Examination Conduction



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Result Analysis was presented before the members. Special care should be taken for the 1st semester subjects Statistics for managers where 41 students failed out of 132 and Information technology for managers where there are 47 failures out of 132.

7. Placement Details

Dr. BalaKoteswari presented the Placement initiatives taken up for employment of the students. Dedicated placement team working on enhancing the skills of the students and grooming the student's right from their inception into the MBA program. Knowing the industry requirement and integrating it with the placement activities is the hallmarks of the placement team. 89 students were placed in reputed companies.

One International and one National Conference were organized on contemporary topic during the pandemic period and participants participated with great enthusiasm.

Dr. R. Lilambeswara Singh said that, research team is shortly publishing the books with ISBN number where selected papers will be published and presently editorial board is working on the same.


